RULES TO ENTER:

- 2. Create a poster and report about that species following the rubric below.
- 3. Use a 22" x 28" poster for the artwork.
- 4. Submit the written report in an envelope attached to back of your poster. The report should be one page double-spaced in size 14 font.
- 5. Obtain parental consent and attach it to the back of your poster. (get form here www.northportfriendsofwildlife.org)
- 6. Turn in poster/essays by May 16 to your teacher.
- 7. Judging will be by the Center For Biological Diversity (Florida Division).
- 8. Winners will be announced around May 24.

RUBRIC TO FOLLOW:

Educational Report (5 points)

- 1) States chosen species and defines whether it is threatened or endangered
- 2) Gives the main threats to chosen species
- 3) States what actions can be taken to protect chosen species
- 4) Describes why conservation and biodiversity are important
- 5) Uses originality in wording (no cutting and pasting from websites)

Creative Poster (5 points)

- 1) Poster has captivating title
- 2) Poster is creative
- 3) Poster is original artwork
- 4) Poster is eye-catching
- 5) Poster message aligns with report
